Teacher/TA onsite	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ Minor disrespect or inappropriate behaviour below the expectations of acceptable behaviour within school during normal operation. ➤ This could include rudeness, disrespect or not following instructions. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ Conversation with pupil which could include a verbal warning, moving seats and other behaviour management strategies. ➤ Contact with parents/carers.
Senior Management Team Member	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ A single use of offensive language (not towards staff). ➤ Aggression towards staff or other pupils. ➤ Unsafe behaviour during the partial closure (this could include deliberately not following instructions for social distancing). 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ Conversation with pupil which could include a consequences, moving seats and other behaviour management strategies. ➤ Contact with student's parents/carers. ➤ Concern logged on CPOMS ➤ On site SLT informed.
Executive Head Teacher or Deputy of any Corvus School	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ If staff have indicated that a police or social services referral is necessary. ➤ Any physically aggressive behaviour towards staff including pinching, biting, spitting. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ➤ Phone call home to parent /carer. ➤ Contact any external agencies involved or make referral to other key agencies. ➤ Log incident on CPOMS. ➤ Temporary exclusion. ➤ Prepare Risk Management Plan (RMP) for when pupil returns. Ensuring that staff/pupils are adequately protected from perpetrator. ➤ Discuss RMP with parents/carers.
