Dear Parents/Carers

We have received a number of phone calls this week asking advice on when to send children to school and when to keep them home if they have a cold or are generally feeling unwell. Please see diagram below for guidance.

However, if your child develops any **one** of the following symptoms then you will need to follow the guidelines of arranging to have your child tested.

Symptoms:

- A high temperature – this means your child feels hot to touch on their chest or back.
- A new continuous cough – this means coughing a lot, **for more than an hour**, or 3 or more coughing episodes in 24 hours.
- A loss or change to sense of smell or taste – this means they cannot smell or taste anything, or things smell or taste different to normal.

If you are unable to book a test, please note that everyone in the household must isolate for 14 days.
