



These maps are just for guidance, you can design your map in any way you like. You can also research different designs—theme parks, zoos and campsites also produce similar style maps to help people find their way around. Your map needs to show different activity locations, accommodation, toilets, first aid, the lake, the forest, entrances, exits, fire points etc.

- ◆ You will need to label your map carefully.
- ◆ You will need to create symbols (toilets, first aid etc.) and a key to show what your symbols represent.
- ◆ What different activities will you include—kayaking, zip wire, outdoor cooking?
