

Comparative adjectives compare one object to another—for example, taller, wider, heavier. Superlative adjectives are the 'biggest' and the 'best'. Think of them as the superheroes of adjectives! For example, fastest, quickest, strongest. Comparatives usually end in 'er' and superlatives end in 'est'. 

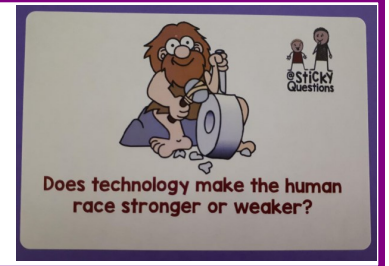
