Daily Phonics

Activities: Here are 3 challenges for you for today linked to the next fortnight's focus of nocturnal animals.

Challenge 1: We learned yesterday that owls are nocturnal. Can you remember what nocturnal means? Think carefully about the animals that come out at night time; they are nocturnal. Can you work with your family to make a list of nocturnal animals. Which ones have you seen before? Put a tick next to them. Are there any animals on this list that you would like to see and haven't yet?

Challenge 2: Using the story prompt card, see if you can re-tell the story of Owl Babies. If you need to remind yourself you can re-watch it here: [Owl Babies](#). Can you remember what Bill says when he is lonely and scared?

Challenge 3: We are carrying on our work on shape today. Watch [session 2's](#) video where you will think about different shapes that are all around us. Have a look where you are sitting—what shapes can you see? Do you know the name of them? You are going to go on a shape hunt around your house looking for 2D, or flat shapes such as squares, rectangles, circles and triangles. How many of each shape can you find?
