Today is

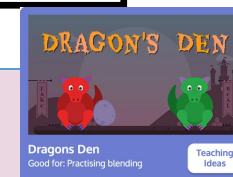
Well-being Wednesday.

This is a chance for you to re-group and catch-up on any work and complete a topic based activity.

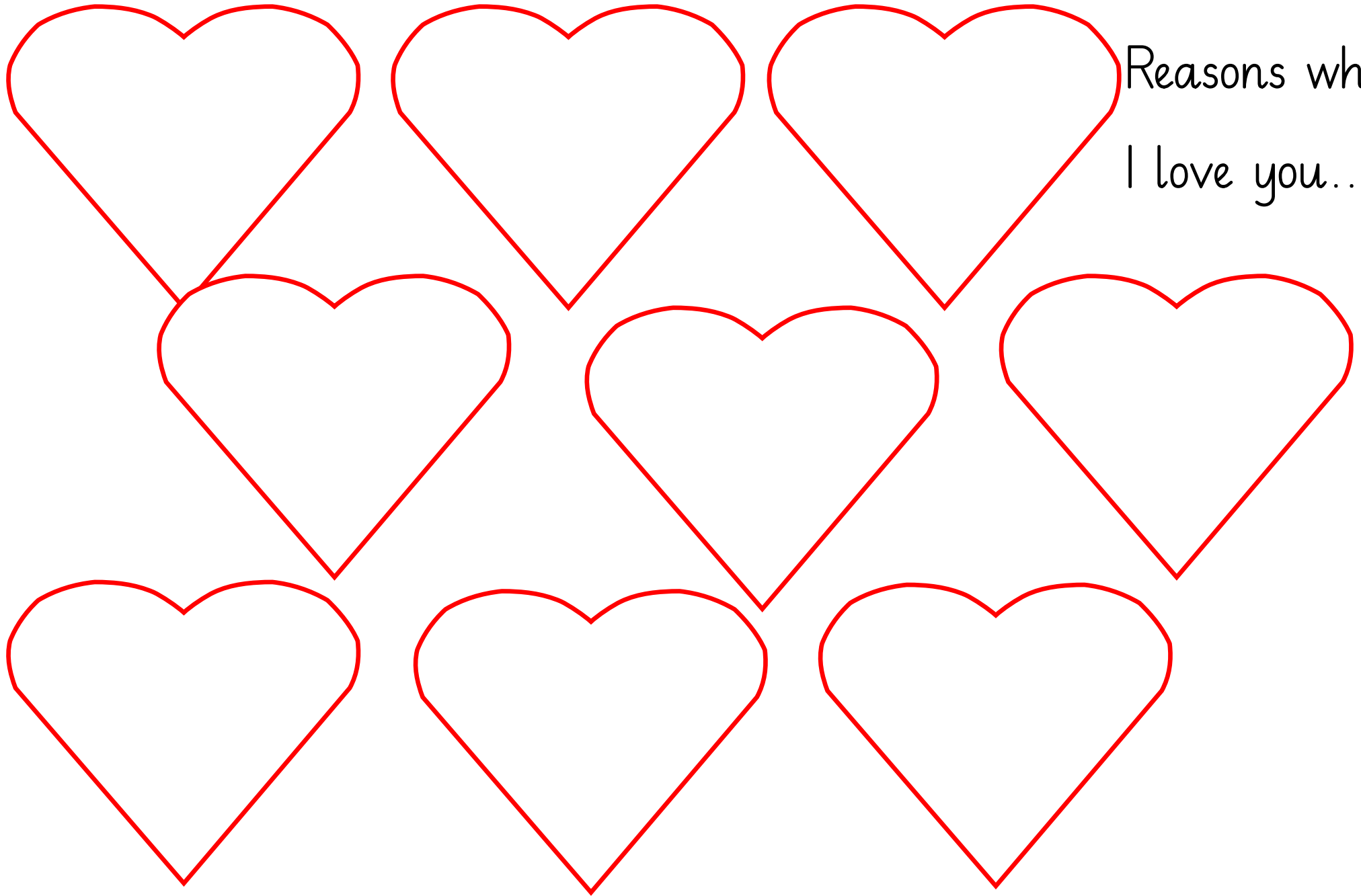
Please note there are now no class Zoom sessions today.

Phonics	<p>Go to Phonics Play</p> <p>Login detail – username : jan21 Password : home</p> <p>Click on the Dragons Den game, select phase 5. Select the 'ea' or 'ur' sound. When the words come up, blend the word and decide whether it is a real word or fake word. If you think the word is real feed it to the green dragon, if you think the word is fake feed it to the red dragon. Play this with more sounds, the child can pick their favourite or practice all phase 5 sounds</p>
A challenge for today	<p>Listen to a piece of Traditional Chinese Music: Chinese Music What does it make you think of and have you heard anything similar to it before? What musical instruments do you think are being played?</p> <p>Keep the piece of music playing, to inspire you while you draw or paint a picture of some Chinese New Year celebrations. You could include; fireworks, lanterns, Chinese dragons, Chinese writing and the lucky colour red in your artwork.</p>
