Daily Phonics

Pick a sound from phase 3 on your sound mat. Say a word that contains that sound. Pick another sound and repeat, You could challenge someone else by giving them a sound to think of a word for you they can pick one for you.

We are learning the last sound in phase 3 today! You have worked so hard on all these new sounds, something especially hard to do in lockdown, so a huge well done for all your amazing hard work. Today's story is [Six Dinner Sid](#) and the sound is /er/. Play the /er/ reading game. Roll a dice, read the word you land on as you travel along the board.

Activities: Here are 4 challenges for you for today.





















Challenge 1: One part of the Chinese new year celebrations is the dragon dancing. Today you are going to make a dragon and make up your own dragon dance. Firstly make your dragon. You will need the two long strips of paper from your pack. This video shows you how to make a concertina middle for your dragon (watch from 15seconds onwards—it is showing you how to make a caterpillar but the principle is the same!) [Concertina demonstration](#) You will then need to make a dragon head to attach to one end. You can put the dragon on 2 sticks (one at the head and one at the tail) or on the strings as shown in the video to make it dance. Watch these clips of dragon dancing and make up your own. Challenge 2: Have a go at the maths video—are you quicker this time recognizing the number that is being shown?

Challenge 3: There were 6 red lanterns and 3 yellow lanterns hanging in a row. How many lanterns were there altogether? You could draw a picture to help you work out the answer. Can you make up your own lantern questions and solve them?

Something physical: Try drawing your name and some of the Chinese numbers (copies in your pack). Can you trace/copy the shapes? You could do this with a pencil or pen, floor chalks, or with a paintbrush dipped in water on an outside wall or floor.
