Daily Phonics

Today we are going to start by recapping all the sounds and doing some word writing.

Play fastest finger first to warm you up and then watch the phonics video and write the words with me.

Watch the [Phonics Wizards](#) singing about our tricky words from phase 3.

Activities: Here are 4 challenges for you for today.

Challenge 1: Our new core story starts today. Today we are going to make predictions about the story. Have a look at picture 1 on page 2. What do you think is happening? Who do you think this is? What are they doing? Why? Where might they be going? Now look at picture 2 on page 3. What is new? Revisit the questions above—do you want to change or add to any of your ideas? Now listen to the story clip.

Challenge 2: Imagine you are going on an adventure. What are you going to hunt for? (Ideally not gold as this will feature in a future task!). What planning might you need to do? Write a list or draw a plan for your hunt, where might you go? What might you need? What will you need to do?

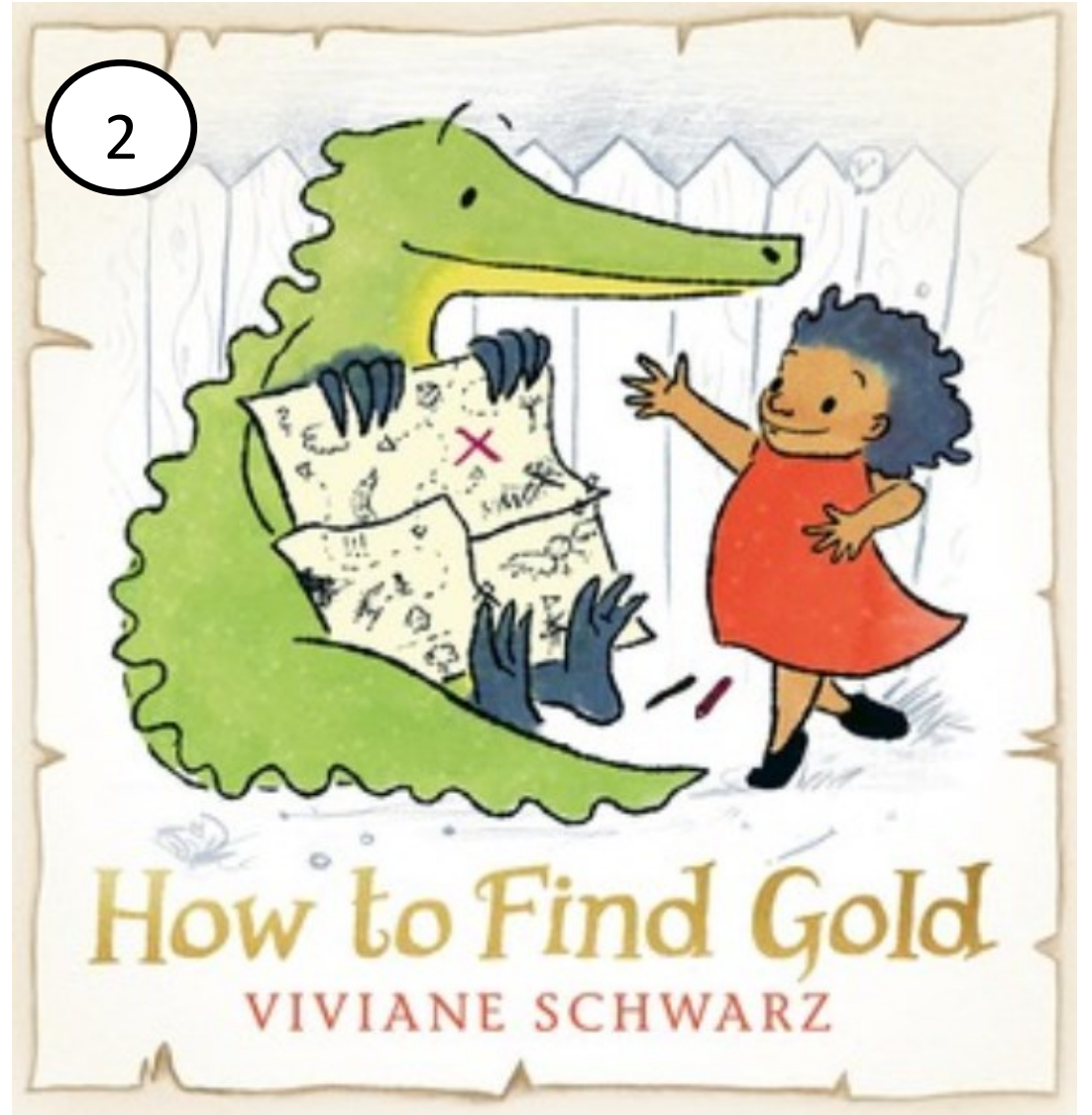
Challenge 3: We are revisiting combining amounts to make an amount today. Look at the dominoes on page 3 or use a set of real dominoes if you have some. Can you combine the amounts on each side of the domino and find another domino with the same total? How many can you match up? Are there any with no one to partner?

Challenge 4: Visit your garden or go for a walk, what do you notice is changing around you? What season are we moving into? How do you know? Can you spot any of the signs on page 4?
