⇒ Make a puffin beak or stripy puffin headband to wear in our Zoom meeting.

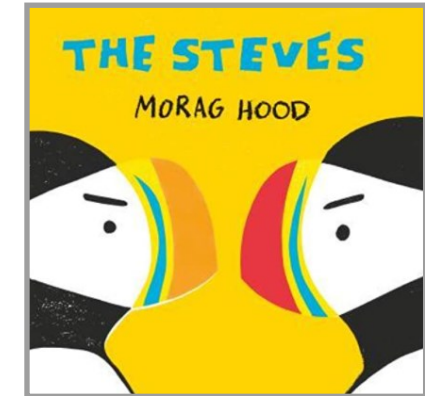
⇒ In the UK, Puffins are famously found on Skomer Island. Where is Skomer? Why do puffins nest and flock to this location?

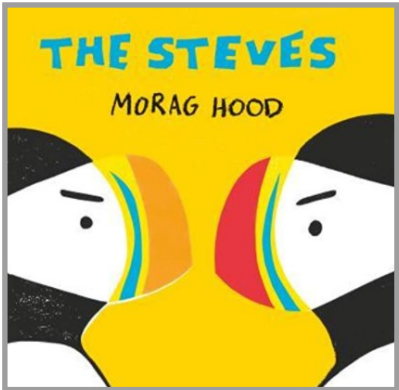

- ◇ Sub-titles and headings with key information
- ◇ Pictures with descriptive captions
- ◇ Labels
- ◇ Bullet point facts and information—technical language
- ◇ A fun facts section
- ◇ Links to websites or sources of further information

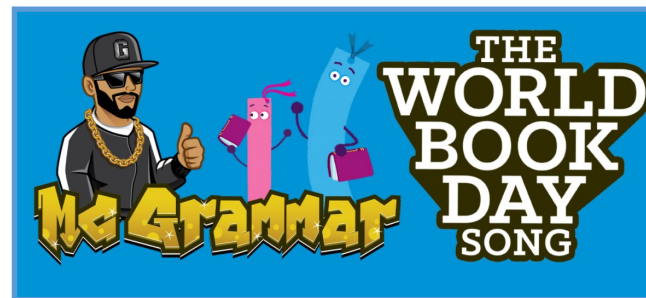

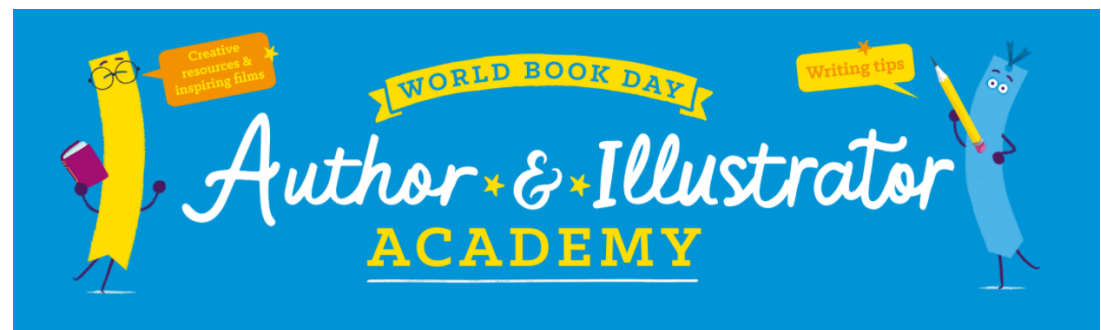
