

We will be learning:

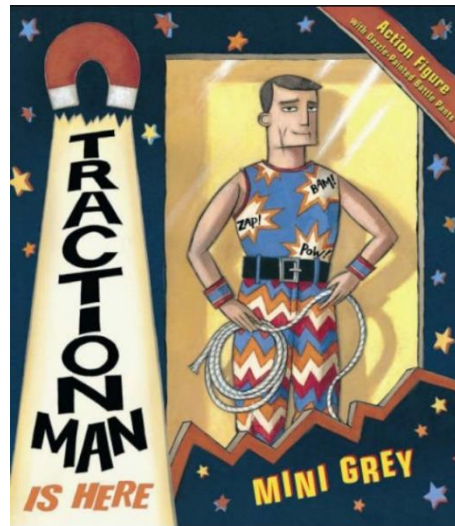
- About everyday superheroes – people who help us in our community.

Key skills for your child:

- To be able to share and take turns with friends.
- To be able to get changed independently and look after their belongings.
- To hold a pencil correctly and begin to develop good pencil control.
- To write CCVC/CVCC (consonant, consonant, vowel, consonant eg: trap) words using segmenting to help.
- To recognise numbers to 10 as numerals and amounts.
- To be able to count accurately beyond 10.
- To develop stronger and more accurate fine motor control using a range of tools such as scissors and tweezers
- To talk about their own toys and toys from the past, being able to recognise what is special to themselves.
- To know that lives have changed over time.
