Here is a snapshot of the learning in Aslacton this week:

Owls have been finding out about dinosaurs and thinking about how we know about the past. We have also been learning about one more and one less in maths. We have been writing descriptions of sticks and using our imagination playing “this is not a stick, it’s a...” We had some great ideas. This week, Kestrels have been ordering and comparing two-digit, three-digit and four-digit numbers in maths. In English we have written the next part of our core story, Ug, in the form of a comic strip. We have also been busy creating harvest wreaths to display in church and designing Picasso inspired portraits as part of our work for European Day of Languages. Eagles have enjoyed writing a script for a Stone Age recipe dish. This week, we worked in groups to record a food advertising video with lots of expression, imagination and description. In Maths, we have worked with accuracy to add and subtract 5-digit numbers using a formal method. In Science, we carried out an exciting investigation into the thermal insulating properties of different materials. We finished the week with our daily mile and a Spanish lesson for European Day of Languages. A busy and fun week!
