Clothing

Welly Boots:

Show and Tell

PE

It is our aim that PE will take place on a Monday, Wednesday and Thursday, however with the weather being more uncertain we may change it at short notice to ensure we are able to hold our lessons. PE kits should be in school every Monday and can be taken home for washing if you wish over a weekend.

PE kits need to include: t shirt, shorts, **jumper, joggers/leggings** and trainers. Please include a pair of shorts as well as leggings/joggers they are not able to go on the indoor gymnastic equipment in leggings and trousers.

Please ensure everyone has a **change of socks**, especially if they are wearing tights, although sometimes we need them if our feet get wet too.

Reading books and home/ school message book

We are moving over to an electronic reading record, of which more details will follow. To start with we will send home books without a record. We will also send home a book bag. Please ensure this is in school every day.

The yellow books are to be used for messages and other communications such as changes to pick ups etc. These are checked daily.
