EYFS

61% of pupils achieved a Good Level of Development. Last year's national figure was 69%

Phonics results

In Year 1, 60.3% of pupils achieved the expected standard in phonics which is lower than this year's national average of 81%.

In Year 2, 33.3% of pupils who had not achieved the standard in Year 1, achieved the expected standard in phonics.

In Reading, Writing and Maths combined 29.1% achieved the 'expected' standard which is lower than last year's national of 60%.

The school has attended statutory moderation and all results have been ratified.

Results in the Early Years Foundation Stage have improved significantly from the previous year. The school has invested heavily in improving the learning environment and is now focused on the quality of teaching and learning. Improving Phonics at Watton Westfield is a priority.
